PROCEDURE POKE SIDE OF STANDING STALKS WITH AN AWL TO RELEASE ANY SITTING WATER PULL PLANT LABEL AND YANK OUT STAKE. IF BROKEN, PRY OUT WITH SHOVEL. IF PLANT LABEL POINTS UP NEXT TO STAKE, REPLACEMENT WAS PLANTED CUT BLACKENED STALK AND FOLIAGE DOWN TO SOLID SECTION ABOVE GROUND SALVAGE WOODEN GOLF TEES. CARDINAL RULE - STERILIZE ALL CUTTING TOOLS USED BETWEEN EACH CLUMP

TRIM TAIL ROOTS. TRASH ROTTED TUBERS. TRASH TUBERS WITH BROKEN NECKS

NOTE - STRAINED NECKS CAN BE REPAIRED WITH CRAZY GLUE SOMETIMES.

CUT STALK DOWN TO HIGHEST TUBER. LOOK FOR BROWN SMOKE RING INDICATING START OF ROT

EYES MAY BE APPARENT OR NOT SO JUST CUT TUBER TO GET SOME OF THE CROWN.

LEAVE SHORT HAIR ROOTS ALONE. THEY WILL SWELL FIRST WHEN PLANTED.

ALWAYS DOUBLE CHECK WHERE THE KNIFE WILL GO BEFORE CUTTING. CUT AWAY FROM YOU

THE FIRST THOUSAND WILL BUILD A MUSCLE MEMORY FOR THE NEXT THOUSAND.

TRIM ALL NECROTIC TISSUE TO REVEAL CLEAN TISSUE ESPECIALLY ON THE CROWN

KEEP TRACK OF VARIETY:

USING BLACK SHARPIE MARKING PEN, MARK EACH TUBER WITH CLASS # AND VARIETY INITIALS DOUBLE CHECK AGAINST THIS YEAR'S VARIETY LISTING USING CURRENT CHD / COMPOSITE

INSIDE PROCESSING SETUP - ITEMS FOR FUNGICIDE WET DIP:

2 - 6 QUART CLEAR PLASTIC SHOEBOX CONTAINERS

OXO STRAINER TO PROCESS FUNGICIDE DIP

PLASTIC TONGS TO AVOID TOUCHING FUNGICIDE DIP

MEASURING AND STIRRING SPOONS

VARIOUS FUNGICIDES: ONE TABLE SPOON EACH, (AT MOST), PER 6 QUART DIP

CAPTAN, CLEARY'S-3336F, FUNGINOL, COPPER FUNGICIDE,

INSIDE PROCESSING SETUP - FUNGICIDE WET DIP PROCEDURE:

DUNK ALL THE FRESHLY CUT TUBERS INTO WET DIP

DURATION OF DUNK DEPENDS ON HOW LONG TO CUT UP NEXT CLUMP AND MARK

ALL OF THE TUBERS SHOULD SINK TO BOTTOM

FLOATERS INDICATE ROT EITHER TAIL, OR BODY, OR CROWN DEPENDING ON POSITION OF FLOAT

REMOVE WITH TONGS AND START CUTTING TO FIND OUT WHERE.

STRAIN OUT TUBERS BY POURING FROM ONE SHOEBOX TO THE EMPTY ONE

WITH TONGS REMOVE TUBERS WITH PLANT LABELTO BED OF CEDAR SHAVINGS IN EMPTY BOX

COVER WITH SHAVINGS AND CURE FOR A DAY OR TWO WITH OPEN COVER.

INSIDE PROCESSING SETUP - ITEMS FOR DRY FUNGICIDE SHAKE-N-BAKE

POWDERED SULFUR - ONE TABLE SPOON

1 CUP OF FINE VERMICULITE

COMBINE ABOVE IN 1 GALLON ZIP LOC BAG AND ZIP SHUT

THROW IN TUBERS AND COAT THEM BY ROTATING THE SEALED BAG

REMOVE WITH LATEX OR NITRILE GLOVES ON AND COVID MASK TO AVOID INHALING

DON'T GET THE SULFUR IN YOUR EYES.
ALTERNATE TO SULFUR IS HYDROLIZED LIME, IE. POWDERED BARN LIME - LESS EXTREME.
DON'T GET EITHER IN YOUR EYES.
INSIDE PROCESSING SETUP - SARAN WRAP STORAGE METHOD
CLEAR PLASTIC SARAN WRAP CAN BE USED TO PREVENT TRANSMISSION OF ROT FROM ONE
TUBER TO THE NEXT AND TO RETAIN TUBER MOISTURE IN PENCIL THIN TUBERS AND / OR NECKS
REPLACES AN OLDER METHOD OF WAXING TUBERS WITH PARAFIN 'GULF WAX' NORMALLY
USED IN CANNING FRUITS AND VEGETABLES. SAME COATING AS IS ON RAW RUTABAGA.
PERIODIC FOLLOWUP OF STORAGE:
AT LEAST WEEKLY, VIEW EACH CONTAINER FOR CONDENSATION ON THE INSIDE WHICH INDICATES
TOO MUCH MOISTURE IN THE STORAGE. CHANGE MEDIUM AND CHECK FOR ROT.
AT LEAST MONTHLY, OPEN EACH CONTAINER AND REMOVE ROT AND ADDRESS SHRIVEL.
LIGHT MOLD CAN BE BRUSHED OFF. SARAN WRAP SHOULD BE UN-WRAPED AND RE-WRAPED
EXPERIMENT CONTINUES WITH HYDROGEN PEROXIDE TO KILL MOLD.
